

MARSHWOOD VALE YOUNG FARMERS PLOUGHING MATCH



Ploughing Match Rules

- 1. No competitors may enter more than one class
- 2. Competitors must report to the office by 9:30, ploughing to commence at 10:00
- 3. Only 3 sighting poles to be used, No rolling of the split.
- 4. The plough must not be in the ground on the site other than on the competitor's plot.
- 5. Complete split by 10:30 or penalty point may be incurred.
- 6. Work will re-start when the judge says and ploughing must be finished by 2:00pm points will be deducted for late finish.
- 7. Double split method of opening to be used. After judging, plough 3 times around opening and then throw abroad against the plot adjacent to the higher number.
- 8. Each competitors finish furrow to be thrown towards his own ridge.
- 9. Minimum depth 5" maximum 8" unless stated on the day.
- 10. The committee reserve the right to amalgamate any class if insufficient entries are received.
- 11. The size and shape of some plots may be altered, pending entries.
- 12. Skimmers may be used
- 13. Plough bodies must be in the ploughing position at all times.
- 14. Vary width ploughs must be set at the commencement of the match and not altered.
- 15. Pressing of the ridge by hand, foot or the boot, slide dollies or any other machinery not at work is forbidden.
- 16. Points will be deducted if plot numbers are lost.
- 17. The committee and landowner accept no liability whatsoever for damage or injury sustained at the event.
- 18. All trophies must be signed for at the site office, and returned in good, clean condition. Any damage must be paid for.
- 19. Score sheets are only available after the results are given out.
- 20. Judges' decision is final.

PLOUGHING MATCH CLASSES

YFC Classes

Class 1a- YFC conventional: Open to any YFC Member using a conventional plough, each competitor must be a paid-up member of a club affiliated to a national federation of Young Farmers Clubs.

Class 1b- YFC Reversible: Open to any YFC Member using a Reversible plough, each competitor must be a paid-up member of a club affiliated to a national federation of Young Farmers Clubs.

There will be a cup for the best Marshwood Vale Young Farmer

Open Classes

CLASS 2- Open 2 Furrows: Open to any plough with 2 furrows

CLASS 3- Open 3 and 4 Furrows: Open to any plough with 3, 4 or more furrows.

CLASS 4- Open Vintage: Open to any tractor and plough Pre 1960 No hydraulic rams or match ploughs.

CLASS 5- Classic: Open to anyone using a tractor manufactured before December 1976 with a Q cab, using a plough manufactured at the time. No hydraulic rams or match ploughs.

Prize money for all classes: 1st £20 2nd £10 and 3rd £5
